In Nomine Matris, first released in Manila in 2013, has been shown in some film festivals, and has won several awards, and was the closing film in the VII Ciclo de Cine y flamenco in Seville, Spain, but has not been widely distributed. The San Francisco Bay Area will have the opportunity to view this most unique film on November 19, 2016 at the New People Cinema. General admission is \$16 and the special donor ticket, which includes admission to the 5:15 reception and the 7:15 screening, is \$50.
